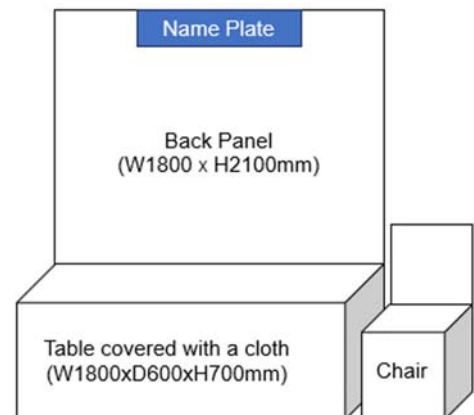

(2) Large Exhibits and Power Requirements

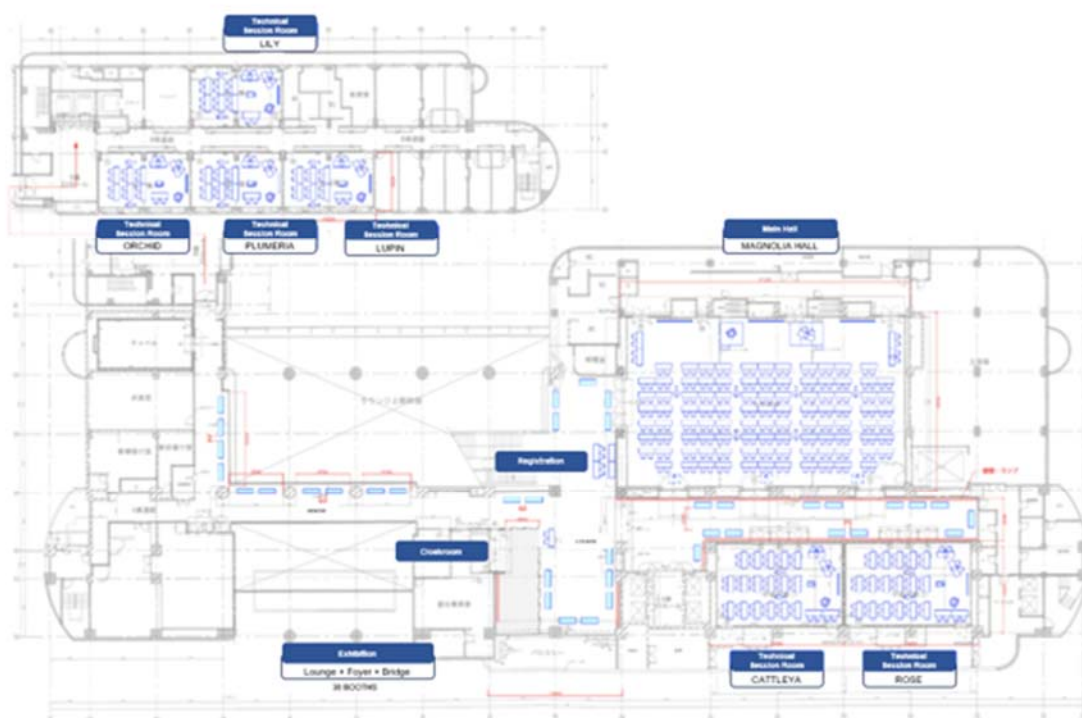
